Research Fund 2023

The Society's Research Fund is intended to help fund small projects. In the last few years grants have been in the range £250-1500.

- 1. **Academic geography staff** in any higher education establishment in the north west of England may submit applications.
- 2. **Research topics** must have **relevance to the north west of England**.
- 3. **Car mileage allowance** should be 40p/mile for the first 150 miles of a round trip, thereafter 10p/mile.
- 4. There is no restriction on the **uses** to which the funds may be put.
- 5. Applicants must submit a **research report or article** suitable for publication in *North West Geography* within a year, or face a ban from further applications for five years.

- 6. The Society will judge applications solely in terms of **quality**.
